

Ministry Name	Purpose Statement
Assimilation	To assist in fostering relationships for new members at World Victory International Christian Center. As new members collaborate with a connection partner, we hope to form bonds, help make connections with other members and ministries, understand the church's ethos, and become an integral part of the church community
Cares Ministry	To assist families in need within our communities in connecting with community resources, with a primary focus on senior citizens.
Congregational Life	To serve the congregation through corporate gatherings such as Friends and Family Day, and acknowledgements for Mother's Day, and Father's Day.
Dance Ministry	To usher in the presence of God through movement and expressions of art of dance through praise and worship to our Lord Jesus Christ. We honor God by letting the Holy Spirit use the ministry of dance to draw people into His presence.
Deacons Ministry	To serve as covenant partners of World Victory and support the body of Christ through acts of service in communion, altar call, baptism, intercessory prayer, financial benevolence, and special events.
Door Knocking Ministry	To minister to our local neighborhood by sharing our faith, inviting individuals to our church, and providing information about our church, and praying for them. We also provide special transportation needs for church ministry trips.
Greeters	To be a welcoming face to members and visitors as they enter the sanctuary.
Life Groups	To encourage cross generation fellowship outside the four walls of the church. Members meet to share a short lesson followed by an open discussion and practical application of biblical principles.
Media	To provide and utilize technical expertise in handling visual media church equipment, editing of church media videos.
Nursing Home Ministry	To serve the elderly, sick, shut-in, and those who cannot help themselves.
Security/ Parking	To be the first welcoming face seen by members and visitors alike when entering the Cliffwood Drive Campus and to direct individuals to the main entrance of the Church and provide a safe and secure place for WVICC family and guest to worship and praise the Lord.
Transportation	To provide transportation for people needing rides to church on Sundays, as well as assisting the WVICC daycare and after school care with transportation. We also provide special transportation needs for church ministry trips.
Usher Ministry	To serve the congregation by greeting and seating people as they arrive for the service and assisting with special needs during the service.
Victory Kids	To help our children and youth discover and develop their gifts through a personal relationship with Jesus Christ through authentic worship and Biblical education.

Victory Learning Center	To provide an amazing developmental and educational experience for children and their families. We offer programs for children starting from 6 weeks – 12 years of age. encouraging your child to learn new skills through self-selected, hands-on activities that make learning engaging and fun for all ages.
